

Food

including: nuts, seafood, meats (with or without bone), tea/coffee residue, animal food, solid dairy products, etc.



Heavily soiled cardboards, papers, and containers

including: muffin baking cups, paper bags, newspapers, paper towels, tissues, parchment paper, etc.



Other materials accepted:

paper straws, wooden utensils, hair and feathers
